ONE COUNTDOWN 2025: A COUNTDOWN FOR EVERYONE, EVERYWHERE

ONE Countdown 2025 will usher in the new year, with celebrations across multiple locations and fireworks displays at various countdown celebration sites across the island. SG60 is a time for Singaporeans to *connect* with their fellow citizens and ONE Countdown is the first event to kick off SG60 commemorations. In addition to Marina Bay, Singapore Sports Hub, Sentosa, Orchard Road and Clarke Quay, there are 17 heartland sites, so Singaporeans can enjoy the festivities with their respective local communities, without having to travel out of their neighbourhoods. For migrant workers, there will also be countdown celebrations at Migrant Worker Recreation Centres (RCs) and Dormitories.

The Ministry of Manpower (MOM) has thus collaborated with our partners to organise a Countdown 2025 programme for MWs so that MWs can also join in the celebrations to usher in the new year. The activities focus on MWs who live in dormitories and will be held at convenient spaces for MWs to increase their participation. Large-scale countdown events will be held at 6 MOM and NTUC-operated RCs from 7.00pm till midnight encompassing a rich pipeline of activities including performances by local and foreign artistes, free food giveaway, carnival games, lucky draws and a dance party. As a key highlight of countdown event, MWs can also look forward to fireworks and outdoor pyrotechnics display at 2 of the RCs at midnight. More than 10 large dormitories will also organise New Year's Eve celebrations for their dorm residents with a lineup of games, performances and snacks that will end late into the night.
